Background: Shetland's earliest mention may be a Latin text about Agricula's circumnavigation of the Britiksh Isles, which reads: '*Dispecta est et Thule*' ('and even thule was sighted'). But scholars still argue about wether Thule was Fair Isle or Foula, or Faroe or Iceland, so the first written records of Shetland are really Norse sagas. For over 600 years after the Viking invasions in the late 8th centuries AD, the islands' trade, language and social life were thoroughly Norwegian. Shetland became the northern third of the great earldom based on Orkney during the golden age of the Vikings, chronicled in the Orkneyinga Saga – which contains numerous references to the islands. In 1263 King Harald of Norway's fleet rendezvoused at *Breideyarsund* (probably Bressay Sound, the 'broad islands' in the placename being Bressay and Noss, then joined by a shallow beach at low tide) en route to the Battle of Largs, which marked the end of Norwegian domination on the west coast of Scotland.

Location: Shetland is on longitude 01deg.W of Greenwich and straddles latitude 60degN, 598 miles (962km) north of London and just 400 miles (643km) south of Arctic Circle. This is as far north as St. Petersburg, Russia, or Anchorage, Alaska.

Area: By far the largest island is the 'Mainland' (351 sq.miles / 899km2) followed by Yell (212km2), Unst (120km2), Fetlar (38km2), Bressay (28km2), Whalsay (23km2), Burra (16km2).

Population: 22,500

Nationality: Scots.

Ethnic Groups: By the latter part of Shetland's Viking Age some of the ruling families were half Norwegian and half Scots. In those days the distinction would not have mattered much anyway. But well into the 19th century most Shetlanders would have had four Shetland-born grandparents.

Languages: Scottish Language, dialect of the English language, Scottish Gaelic. **Currency:** 1 British pound = 100 pence
