

Background: One of the poorest countries in the Western Hemisphere, Haiti has been plagued by political violence for most of its history. Over three decades of dictatorship followed by military rule ended in 1990 when Jean-Bertrand ARISTIDE was elected president. Most of his term was usurped by a military takeover, but he was able to return to office in 1994 and oversee the installation of a close associate to the presidency in 1996.

Economy: About 80% of the population lives in abject poverty. Nearly 70% of all Haitians depend on the agriculture sector, which consists mainly of small-scale subsistence farming and employs about two-thirds of the economically active work force. The country has experienced little job creation since President PREVAL took office in February 1996, although the informal economy is growing. Failure to reach agreements with international sponsors have denied Haiti badly needed budget and development assistance. Meeting aid conditions in 2000 will be especially challenging in the face of mounting popular criticism of reforms.

Visa: Not required for touristec stays of up to 90 days.

Duty Free: goods permitted: 200 cigarettes or 50 cigars of 1 kg of tobacco; 1 litre of spirits; small quantity of perfume or eau de toilette for personal use.

Health: A yellow gever vaccination certificate is required from teavellers coming from infected areas. Malaria risk, in the malignant falciparum form, exists throughout the year in certain forest areas. All water should be regarded as being potentially contaminated Water used for drinking, brushing teeth or making ice should have first

been boiled or otherwise sterilised. Health insurance providing cover for repatriation in the event of serious illness is strongly recommended.
